Inviting you!...

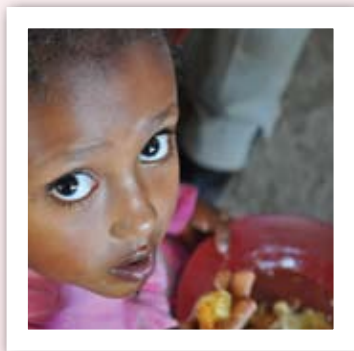
We invite you to care for orphans who may never be adopted by partnering in our Christian School and Caretaker program. Consider giving a 2 or 3 year commitment to 'adopt' the Lifesong Christian School initiative:

- Yearly mission trips to see the work, meet and encourage the school staff, work with the children, run a VBS, help with minor construction and generally bring the love of Jesus to those in need
- Write letters to children that you can sponsor. Encourage them and point them to Jesus
- Financially support the work of the school. Help provide necessary buildings, improvements, school supplies, materials to assist the indigenous staff in their daily teaching and discipleship



Lifesong's Commitment

- **Stewardship** – 100% of every donated dollar will go to its intended use – orphan care or adoption grants / loans
- **Guide the ministry** – we will ensure that our Lifesong Zambia program maximizes stewardship and changes as many lives as possible
- **Facilitate Mission Trips** – we will help with travel arrangements, trip planning and facilitation
- **Facilitate Letter-writing** – we will translate and deliver letters on a quarterly or semi-annual basis between the child and the sponsor(s)

In summary, we are requesting First Baptist Church to make a 2-3 year commitment in these 3 areas:

2. Letter-writing to children on (quarterly or semi-annual basis)
3. Consider financially supporting the education, discipleship, and nutrition for 230 children at the Lifesong Zambia School
