Sadly, 163 million children in our country and around the world won't have these experiences. They are orphans, and will grow up without knowing the love and security of close family bonds.

We want to help change this. We have organized a work-a-thon for September 18, called a Both Hands project. Our team of family and friends will be working on a widow's home, and the money we raise through sponsorships will go to Lifesong for Orphans, which provides Christian families with grants for their adoptions. One hand for the widow, one hand for the orphan.



Margaret McHenry will be benefiting from our labor. Mrs. McHenry was widowed five years ago, and has not been able to fix some significant plumbing issues in her home. She also needs a bathroom renovation, some painting, and some minor maintenance projects.

We have three biological children, and will soon be adopting a newborn through an African American infant program. Our adoption is one of several that will be assisted through this project.
